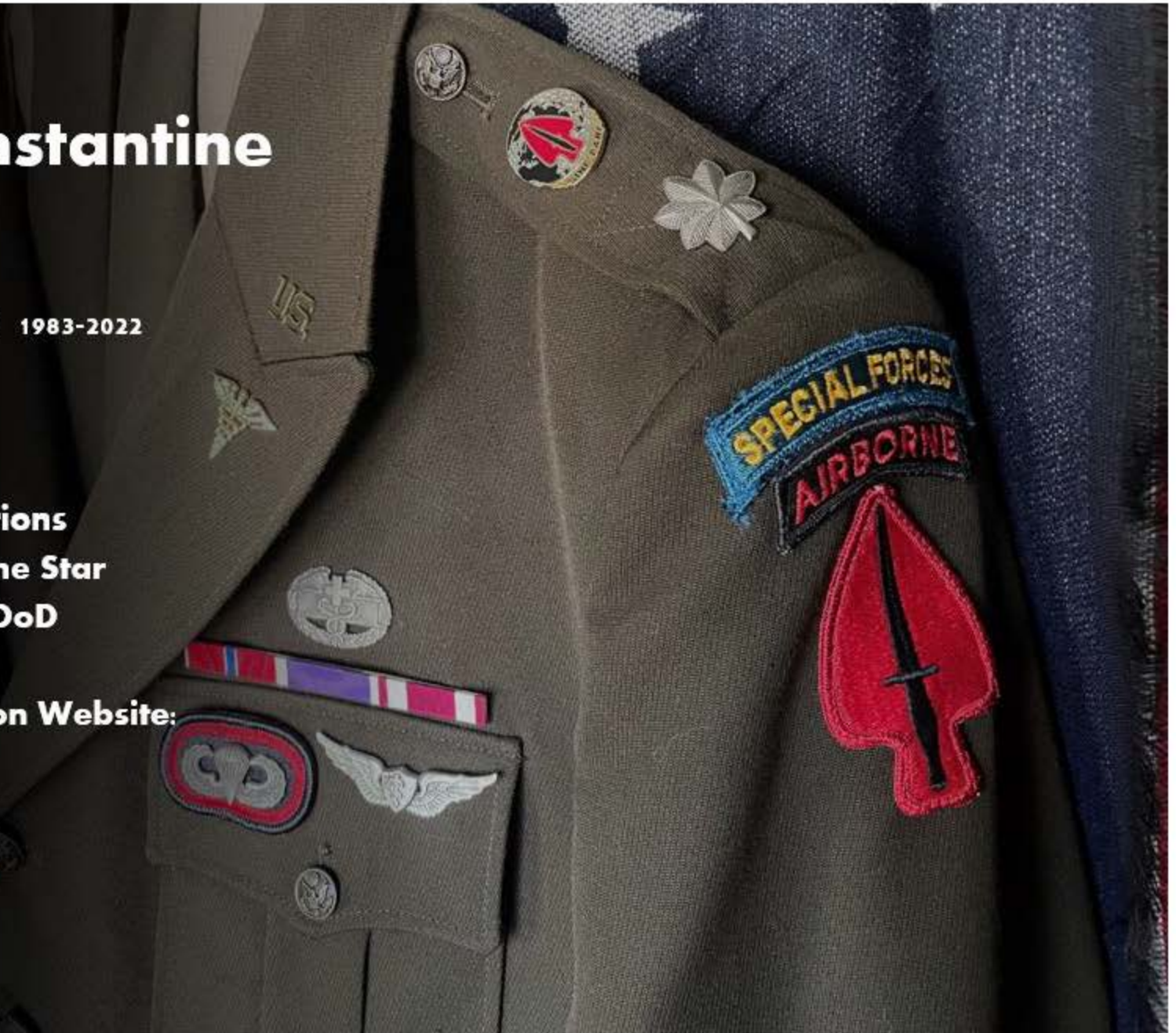

**LIEUTENANT COLONEL PETER CONSTANTINE CHAMBERS, D.O.**  
**U.S. ARMY SPECIAL FORCES (RET.)**

LTC Pete Chambers joined the army in 1983 and served for a career spanning 39 years. After his first Honorable Discharge he had a break in service to complete college and medical school at the University of New England. He completed a primary care residency and worked as an emergency room physician and was commissioned as a peace officer serving his community as a SWAT team physician and sheriff's deputy. After the United States was attacked on 9/11, he returned to the US Army Special Forces.

He is a graduate of the Special Forces Qualification Course, earning the Green Beret. He has multiple combat tours, deploying in the capacity of Special Operations Flight Surgeon and Green Beret Commander conducting foreign internal defense missions around the globe.

His last two Stateside deployments in Texas were as a liaison to Governor Gregg Abbott's TASK FORCE during the Texas COVID response (2020) and deployed to the border of South Texas on Operation Lone Star as a Task Force Surgeon. (2021). He has been awarded the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, and the Combat Medical Badge.

Until recently he had remained off the media grid, until he was revealed by Senator Ron Johnson as a "whistleblower" exposing facts related to the Defense Medical Epidemiology Database. He then joined forces with other frontline doctors to provide fidelity on safety issues regarding both civilian and military aviation safety. He testified as a fact witness in Liberty Counsel's SEALs v. DoD case and has traveled the nation speaking on medical freedom and National Defense issues.

In 2023 he stood up The Republic of Texas', Remnant A-Team, a ministry with focus on community service, border issues and the State of Texas' security issues with a heavy emphasis on the human toll. His team has advised local and state law enforcement and community groups to strengthen ties and resolve to organize effective community response to any disaster, natural or manmade.

His team's motto; "Ever Stalwart."

### Some Eligibility Requirements for Joining the Army Medical Corps

- Commissions are available to qualified physicians in the Regular Army (RA) and Army Reserve (AR).
- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen for Regular Army or a permanent resident for Army Reserve.
- Regular Army and Army Reserve applicants must have a Doctor of Medicine or Osteopathy Degree from an accredited U.S. School of Medicine or Osteopathy. Foreign graduates may apply if they have a permanent certificate from the Educational Council of Foreign Medical Graduates.
- Must have completed at least one year of an approved Graduate Medical Education (GME) internship.
- Must hold a current, valid, active and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the U.S., District of Columbia or Puerto Rico.
- Must be at least board eligible.

The demands on an SF operator are extreme that require not only mental ability but also motivation and physical ability; among other things. It will be important that you learn to leverage this strength to offset many of the other challenges you will face in a job like this.

Based on your Land Navigation performance it appears as though you have the mental and physical ability to learn and demonstrate new skills. This will be important as you prepare for SF because SF operators will constantly face new challenges that they must quickly learn and apply in the operating environment. It will be important to continue to work both physically and mentally on new challenging training events, as you prepare for SF.

It appears as though you demonstrated motivation throughout SFAS and that is extremely important to being successful in SF. Outside of Character, your motivation is the most important attribute you must embody to succeed in SF. However, motivation alone will not ensure success in SF. You must also demonstrate a high level of ability in a variety of attributes to be successful. In areas where you lack ability motivation may help to compensate. It will be important to identify you weaknesses and then utilize your high motivation to improve in those areas.

It appears as though you have the physical ability to succeed in SF. However, having the ability and utilizing that ability are two separate things. The demands on an SF operator are extreme that require not only physical ability but also motivation, people skills, and good judgment. Being physically fit will prevent you from being overly fatigued, giving you an advantage to focus on other pressing issues. It will be important that you learn to leverage this strength to offset many of the other challenges you will face in a job like this.

You demonstrated the ability to influence others throughout SFAS. This is an important skill for SF, because an important aspect of an SF operator's job is to have the ability to influence people. This goes beyond interacting well with teammates but also having the ability to effectively interact with other military personnel, civilians, and people for other countries. This is a skill that will always require additional practice. It is recommended that you continue to practice this skill by studying different cultures and finding opportunities to interact with people of different nationalities.

You demonstrated good judgment during SFAS. This is an important for an SF operator because he will be called to make decisions with little oversight. While you demonstrated good judgment during selection there is always room for improvement. You will find yourself in unconventional, dynamic, and complex environments that will require you to rely on your knowledge and decision making skills. It is recommended that you continue to practice this skill by putting yourself in situations that require a deeper level of thinking. You should also learn from those around you that have more experience.

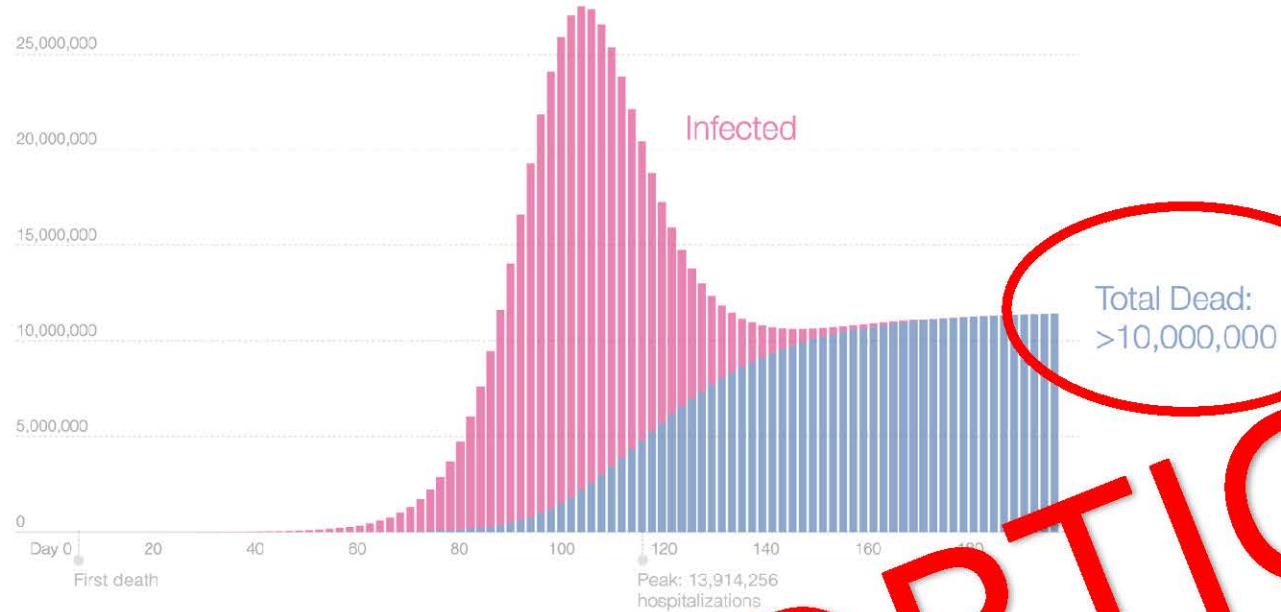

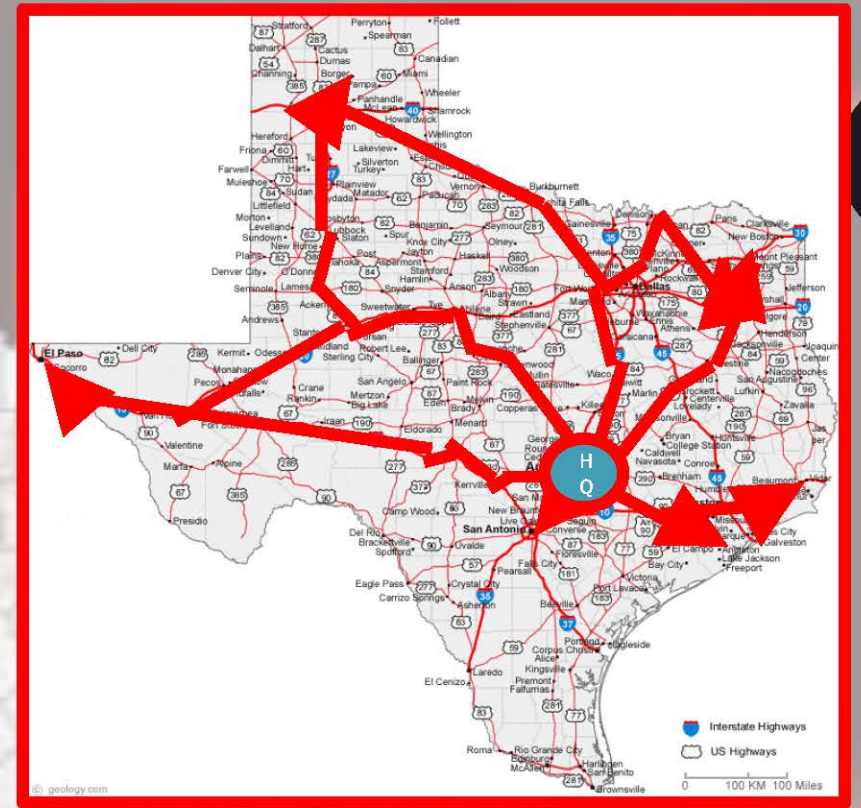

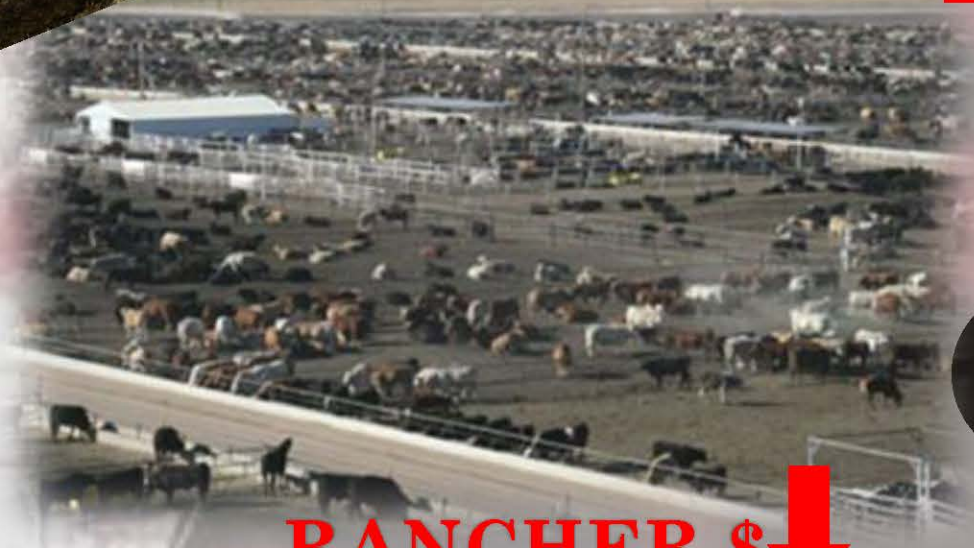

# CURRENT STRATEGY – From SOC



- “Flatten the Curve” Mantra
- Build Bed Capacity (Doesn’t affect disease Morbidity of Mortality – but is PRIMARY Line of Effort for Texas National Guard and TDEM)
- **Consider Prophylaxis for Primary Care Providers, Health Workers, Troops in the Field. (Use of Chloroquine and Hydroxychloroquine or Consider Ivermectin)**
- PPE to Front Lines (**Once again, doesn’t affect disease course**)
- Other ancillary “Shaping” Operations



# ECONOMIC and SOCIAL IMPACTS



- Consider current work coming out of Stanford University Study (Dr. Jay Bhattacharya's work).
- **Balance Work Force Return Safely with Continued Disease Mitigation**
- To do this we must consider current studies. (Imperial College of London shift in stance on infectivity rates, pairing that with Stanford Study)
- Psychological impact on populace is overwhelming – “Perception is their reality.” – Appropriate messaging and **HOPE** is mandatory.

# Imperial College of London Study



- **INITIAL FINDINGS:** Some of the findings of the research are that if no action had been taken against the virus it would have caused 510,000 deaths in Britain and 2.2m in the US.
- **CURRENTLY:** Imperial College Study Author Shifts: Actually, **I Think The Coronavirus Death Toll Will Be Much Lower Than Expected;**  
Update: No Shift?



# Get Texas Back to Work



- Scientific Uncertainty Exists, i.e;
  - A&M Model -33% infectivity rate
  - McKenzie Model – 2 to 15% infectivity rate
- WHO Fatality Rate = **3.4% (Policy is being determined by this number.)**
- Case Fatality Rate – What is it?
- Numerator = # of people who die from COVID-19
  - A hard number that is easy to determine.
- Denominator = Should be the people who've been exposed to the disease and got the disease. (**\*\*\*We can argue there is error in the denominator**)
- Problem: When you measure is the tests being used. Which only indicates that a patient has the rNA Viral Load and currently HAS the disease.  
Question: But, what if you get better?
  - **The Case Fatality Rate is therefore not depictive of actual fatality rate.**

- FACT WITNESS for Servicemembers Seeking Religious Accommodations.

# DECLARATION of MILITARY ACCOUNTABILITY

1 January 2024

An Open Letter to the American People from Signatories of this Declaration of Military Accountability

*"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."*  
—John Adams

In the course of human events it sometimes becomes necessary to admonish the lawless, encourage the faithless, and strengthen the weak. We have reached just such a time in our history. The affairs of our nation are now steeped in avaricious corruption and our once stalwart institutions, including the Dept of Defense, are failing to fulfill the moral obligations upon which they were founded. **Standing upon our natural and constitutional rights**, we hereby apprise the American people that we have exhausted all internal efforts to rectify recent criminal activity within the Armed Forces.

In the Declaration of Independence our founding fathers sought separation. We seek no separation, but through this letter and the efforts we pledge herein, **we pursue restoration through accountability**. We intend to rebuild trust and restore the rule of law, particularly within the Armed Forces. Ultimately, we strive to once again become a moral people, restoring our nation, and making it again worthy of the great gift of liberty won by the colonial-era American people.

While implementing the COVID-19 vaccine mandate, **military leaders broke the law**, trampled constitutional rights, denied informed consent, permitted unwilling medical experimentation, and **suppressed the free exercise of religion**. Service members and families were significantly harmed by these actions. Their suffering continues to be felt financially, emotionally, and physically. Some service members became part of our ever-growing veteran homeless population, some developed **debilitating vaccine injuries**, and some even lost their lives. In an apparent attempt to avoid accountability, military leaders are continuing to ignore our communications regarding these injuries and the laws that were broken.

For GEN Milley, ADM Grady, GEN McConville, ADM Gilday, ADM Lescher, Gen Brown, Gen Berger, Gen Smith, VADM Kilby, VADM Nowell, VADM Fuller, LTG Martin, Lt Gen Davis, MG Edmonson, GEN Williams, ADM Fagan, VADM Buck, Lt Gen Clark, MG Francis, LTG Dingle, Lt Gen Miller, RADM Gillingham, and numerous others;

These individuals enabled lawlessness and the **unwilling experimentation** on service members. The moral and physical injuries they helped inflict are significant. They betrayed the trust of service members and the American people. **Their actions caused irreparable harm** to the Armed Forces and the institutions for which we have fought and bled.

These leaders **refused to resign** or take any other action to hold themselves accountable, nor have they attempted to repair the harm their policies and actions have caused. Since there has yet to be any accountability, the undersigned give our word to do everything morally permissible and legally possible to hold our own leadership accountable. We intend to rebuild trust by demonstrating that **leaders cannot cast aside constitutional rights** or the law for political expediency.

The flag and general officers are far from the only ones complicit in recent illegal activities, as a significant number of SES leaders and political appointees contributed. Evidence indicates that other executive agencies are engaging in illegal activity. However, as service members and veterans, we feel particularly responsible for the DoD and, in accordance with our oaths, we will make every effort to demonstrate by example, **how an institution can put its own house in order**.

We the undersigned, on behalf of hundreds of thousands of service members and the American people, while appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for guidance and purity of intention, **mutually pledge** to each other that we will do everything in our power, through lawful word and action, **to hold accountable military leaders** who failed to follow the law when their leadership and moral courage was most desperately needed.

In the coming years, thousands within our network will run for Congress and seek appointments to executive branch offices, while those of us still serving on active duty will continue to put fulfilling our oaths ahead of striving for rank or position. For those who achieve the lawful authority to do so, **we pledge to recall from retirement the military leaders** who broke the law and will **convene courts-martial** for the crimes they committed. For those of us who attain legislative offices, we pledge to **introduce legislation to remove all retirement income** for the military leaders who were criminally complicit, and we will **ensure none serve in or retire from the Senior Executive Service**.

This endeavor will be a continuous process with a long-term time horizon, but fulfilling our oaths to defend the Constitution requires just such persistent vigilance. Likewise, we are obligated, and so commit, to train those who come after us to fulfill their duty in achieving this accountability and **safeguarding against such leadership failures hereafter**.

Our nation was once great because it was good. It was built on moral principles founded in natural law and yet, the recent acceleration of moral relativism has us headed towards a precipitous implosion. While all good things come to an end, **we refuse to allow our nation to go quietly into the depths of decadence and decay**. We promise to exhaust all moral, ethical, and legal means to restore the rule of law and will begin by attempting to hold senior military leaders accountable. The Constitution is the supreme law of our land. **We will fight** to enforce that law and put an end to the two-tiered justice system. May future generations see our efforts and, God willing, may they also be recipients of the great gift of liberty that we have had the honor of safeguarding.
