



BIO LIEUTENANT COLONEL PETER CONSTANTINE CHAMBERS, D.O. U.S. ARMY SPECIAL FORCES (RET.)

LTC Pete Chambers joined the army in 1983 and served for a career spanning 39 years. After his first Honorable Discharge he had a break in service to complete college and medical school at the University of New England. He completed a primary care residency and worked as an emergency room physician and was commissioned as a peace officer serving his community as a SWAT team physician and sheriff's deputy. After the United States was attacked on 9/11, he returned to the US Army Special Forces.

He is a graduate of the Special Forces Qualification Course, earning the Green Beret. He has multiple combat tours, deploying in the capacity of Special Operations Flight Surgeon and Green Beret Commander conducting foreign internal defense missions around the globe.

His last two Stateside deployments in Texas were as a liaison to Governor Gregg Abbott's TASK FORCE during the Texas COVID response (2020) and deployed to the border of South Texas on Operation Lone Star as a Task Force Surgeon. (2021). He has been awarded the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, and the Combat Medical Badge.

Until recently he had remained off the media grid, until he was revealed by Senator Ron Johnson as a "whistleblower" exposing facts related to the Defense Medical Epidemiology Database. He then joined forces with other frontline doctors to provide fidelity on safety issues regarding both civilian and military aviation safety. He testified as a fact witness in Liberty Counsel's SEALs v. DoD case and has traveled the nation speaking on medical freedom and National Defense issues.

In 2023 he stood up The Republic of Texas', Remnant A-Team, a ministry with focus on community service, border issues and the State of Texas' security issues with a heavy emphasis on the human toll. His team has advised local and state law enforcement and community groups to strengthen ties and resolve to organize effective community response to any disaster, natural or manmade.

His team's motto; "Ever Stalwart."

- Must be at least board eligible.

The inter-facility credentials transfer brief (ICTB) documents a health care provider's credentials and is the means by which information is shared between privileging authorities.

The Army requires you to possess a current, valid, unrestricted medical license to practice before granting a medical staff appointment with privileges. The medical license may be from any state, the District of Columbia, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, or the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Practitioners must maintain a current and unrestricted license to see patients. The CCQAS system will automatically notify providers via email when license or certification is due for renewal 90 days prior to expiration of licensure.

The demands on an SF operater are extreme that require not only mental ability but also motivation and phsysical ability; among other things. It will be important that you learn to leverage this strength to offset many of the other challenges you will face in a job like this.

Based on your Land Navigation performance it appears as though you have the mental and physical ability to learn and demonstrate new skills. This will be important as you prepare for SF because SF operators will constantly face new challenges that they must quickly learn and apply in the operating environment. It will be important to continue to work both physically and mentally on new challenging training events, as you prepare for SF.

It appears as though you demonstrated motivation throughout SFAS and that is extremely important to being successful in SF. Outside of Character, your motivation is the most important attribute you must emboby to succeed in SF. However, motivation alone will not ensure success in SF. You must also demonstrate a high level of ability in a variety of attributes to be successful. In areas where you lack ability motivation may help to compensate. It will be important to identify you weaknesses and then utilize your high motivation to improve in those areas.

It appears as though you have the physical ability to succeed in SF. However, having the ability and utilizing that ability are two separate things. The demands on an SF operater are extreme that require not only physicall ability but also motivation, people skills, and good judgment. Being physically fit will prevent you from being overly fatigued, giving you an advantage to focus on other pressing issues. It will be important that you learn to leverage this strength to offset many of the other challenges you will face in a job like this.

You demonstrated the ability to influence others throughout SFAS. This is an important skill for SF, because an important aspect of an SF operator's job is to have the ability to influence people. This goes beyond interacting well with teammates but also having the ability to effectively interact with other military personnel, civilians, and people for other countries. This is a skill that will always require additinoal practice. It is recommended that you continue to practice this skill by studying different cultures and finding opportunities to interact with people of different nationalities.

You demonstrated good judgment during SFAS. This is an important for an SF operator because he will be called to make decisions with little oversite. While you demonstrated good judgment during selection there is always room for improvement. You will find yourself in unconventional, dynamic, and complex environments that will require you to rely on your knowledge and decision making skills. It is recommended that you continue to practice this skill by putting yourself in situations that require a deeper level of thinking. You should also learn from those around you that have more experience.

An Open Letter to the American People from Signaturies of this Declaration of Military Accountability

"Our Commission was made andy for a moral and neligious people. It is rebuily inadequate to the government of any other."

In the course of hustum events it sometimes becomes necessary to advise in the low-less, encourage the fairfile-cated, and strengthen the weak. We have reached just such a time in our history. The affairs of our nation are now steeped in a suricious corruption and our once stalwart ionitiations, including the Dept of Defense, are failing to fairful the moral obligations upon which they were insuded. Standing upon our natural and constitutional rights, we hereby appries the American people that we have exhausted all internal efforts to rectify never criminal activity within the Armed Force.

In the Declaration of Independence our founding fathers sought separation. We seek no separation, but through this fenter and the efforts we pledge herein, we pursue restoration through accountability. We instead to rebuild trust and restores the rule of law, porticularly within the Anned Forces. Ultimately, we strive to once again become a rule restoring our nation, and making it again worthy of the great gift of liberty won by the colonial-real Antarican people.

While implementing the COVID-19 vaccine mondate, military leaders broke the law, trampled continutional rights, detected informed consent, printited unwilling medical experimentation, and suppressed the free exercise of religion. Service members and fantilies were significantly harmed by these actions. Their sufficing coertises to be felt financially, enotionally, and physically. Some service multibers became part of our ever-growing veteran homeless population, some developed debilitating vaccine injuries, and some even lost their lives. For GEN Milley, ADM Grady, GEN McConville, ADM Gilday, ADM Loscher, Gen Brown, Gen Herger, Gen Smith, VADM Killey, VADM Nowell, VADM Fuller, LTG Martin, LT Gen Davis, MC Edenousen, GEN Williams, ADM Fuguet, VADM Black, 13 Gen Clark, MG Francis, LTG Bingle, LT Gen Miller, RADM Gillingham, and numerous others;

These individuals enabled tracteouscus and the unwilling experimentation on service members. The month and physical injuries they helped inflict are significant. They betrueed the trust of service members and the American people. Their actions caused irreparable harm to the Armed Forces and the institutions for which we have fought and blod.
